

Orion® Tritech II Field Tripod with Fluid Pan Head

Tightening the Quick Release Plate

When securing the quick release plate onto the top of the tripod, you should tighten down the “Quick Release Plate Lock Lever” (**Figure 2B** in the tripod manual). In case the locking lever doesn’t fully clamp down on the quick release plate (leaving the plate loose), there is an adjustment to engage the lock lever more tightly:

1. Grab the lock lever with your fingers and gently pull straight out, away from the tripod head. (**Figure A** and **B**). The lever knob is spring loaded and pulls away from the underlying bolt head.
2. While the lever knob is being pulled outwards, rotate it slightly clockwise until it re-seats itself again over the bolt head.
3. The level should now provide more pressure against the quick release plate. You may have to pull the knob away and rotate again until you find the right amount of pressure against the plate to hold it securely.

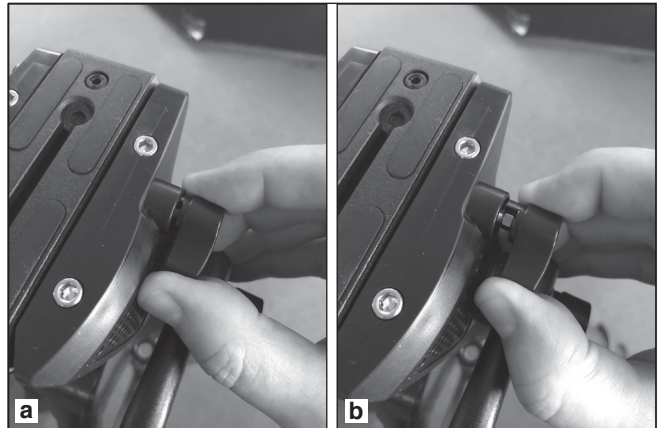


Figure a. Grab the quick release plate lock lever with your fingers.
